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

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CAMPBELLFORD

BY-LAW 1989-54

being a by-law to designate the property known municipally as 37 Saskatoon Avenue as being of architectural and historical value or interest

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act (RSO 1980, ch. 337), as amended, authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest;d

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Towm of Campbellford has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as 37 Sasatoon Avenue and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to designate the said property and has caused notice of intention to be published in the Campbellford Herald, the first publication being July25,1989:

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Campbellford hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the property known municipally as 37 Saskatoon Avenue and more particularly described as part of Mill House Block, Plan 112, Town of Campbellford.
- The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property, described above in the proper land registry office.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality.

DESIGNATION OF PROPERTY

known municipally as 37 Saskatoon Avenue and also described as part of Mill House Block, Plan 112, Town of Campbellford

REASONS FOR DESIGNATION:

The "T" shaped building, probably constructed about 1875, is built of coursed limestone. It is approximately 30' x 24' at the front, while the rear is 20' x 24'. An unusual feature of this house is the single vertical stone pattern bordering both sides of the windows. The front windows have stone sills and all windows have vertical stone headers. Windows are 2 over 2 vertical hung sash. The front doorway has a four-pane transom and panelled sides. It appears that a veranda extended across the full width of the front elevation.
