A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF CARLETON PLACE TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS "THE BRAYDON MILL SITE" AS BEING OF HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OR INTEREST

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1980 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as "The Braydon Mill Site" on Rosamond Street and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Carleton Place enacts as follows:

- 1. There is designated as being of historical and architectural value or interest the real property known as "The Braydon Mill Site", more particularly described as the tract of land and premises being composed of Lot 1, Section 'M', Plan 474, 150 Rosamond Street in the Town of Carleton Place in the County of Lanark.
- 2. The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this Bylaw to be registered against the property described in Item 1 above in the proper land registry office.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this By-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.
