The property subject to this proposed designation is legally described as Part of Lots 11 and 12, Concession 2, City of Cornwall and municipally known as 1128-1130 Capt. MacDonald Road, City of Cornwall.

The primary reasons for designation are of a historical nature and include the fact that the Capt. MacDonald House is the original homestead of Capt. A. J. MacDonald (1824-1913) prominent citizen of Cornwall,

and an example of the transition of a historic vernacular farmhouse style.
