## NOTICE OF HERITAGE DESIGNATION

Downtown Oakville Heritage Conservation District

On February 4, 2013, Oakville Town Council resolved to pass By-law 2013-004 to designate the Downtown Oakville Heritage Conservation District under Part V, Section 41(1) of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. 18, as a heritage conservation district and to adopt the Downtown Oakville Heritage Conservation District Plan and Guidelines.

The Downtown Oakville Heritage Conservation District is within an area roughly the area from just west of Navy Street to Dunn Street, and just north of Randall Street to Robinson Street. See map for details. You are receiving this notice because your property is within the boundary of the Downtown Oakville Heritage Conservation District.

Information relating to the Downtown Oakville Heritage Conservation District, including copies of the District Plan and Guidelines, is available for inspection during normal business hours in Planning Services, Oakville Town Hall, 1225 Trafalgar Road, Oakville or on the Town of Oakville municipal website at www.oakville.ca — search for Downtown Heritage Conservation District.

Any person who objects to By-law 2013-004 may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board by providing the Town Clerk, not later than Friday, March 8, 2013, with a Notice of Appeal. The appeal shall set out the objection to the by-law, the reasons in support of the objection and include the required \$125 filing fee prescribed for under the Ontario Municipal Board Act, payable by certified cheque or money order to the "Minister of Finance." Please be advised that if a Notice of Appeal is received, the matter will be referred to the Ontario Municipal Board.
