## CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PERTH

## BY-LAW NO. 2587

A By-Law to designate a certain property within the Municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest

WHEREAS Chapter 337 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980 provides that the Council of a Municipality may, by by-law, designate a property within the Municipality to be of historical or architectural value or interest.

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate a certain property within the Municipality was served on the owner of the property and the Ontario Heritage Foundation, November 19, 1984 and was published in the Perth Courier November 21, November 28 and December 5, 1984.

AND WHEREAS no objections were received against the designation of the said property as a result of the aforementioned notices:

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Perth ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

The following property be and is hereby designated to be of historic or architectural value or interest:

The Old Burying Ground or the Craig Street Cemetery, Description: lying between Craig and Brock Streets, being Part of Lot 8 and Part of Lot 9 on the North side of Brock Street and the South side of Craig Street on Plan 8828 and more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.

The Corporation of the Town of Perth.

Reason For Designation: This cemetery was used for the first one

hundred years and more after the Perth Military Settlement was established and is the final resting place of Robert Lyon who fell in a duel

with John Wilson in 1833.

The gravestones and fences at the site are in

need of major repairs.

This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the passing thereof. 2.

READ a First, Second and Third Time and passed this eighth day of January, 1985.
