A by-law of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa to designate St. Alban the Martyr Anglican Church, 125 Daly Avenue, to be of historic or architectural value or interest.

WHEREAS The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all the buildings and structures thereon, to be of historic or achitectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa has caused to be served upon the owner of the lands and premises known as St. Alban the Martyr Anglican Church, 125 Daly Avenue, more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in The Ottawa Journal newspaper having a general circulation in the City of Ottawa, once a week for three consecutive weeks, namely on February 21st, February 28th and March 7th, 1978;

AND WHEREAS the reasons for the designation are set out as Schedule "B" hereto;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the said proposed designation has been served upon the Clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of historic or architectural value or interest the real property, more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto, known as St. Alban the Martyr Anglican Church, 125 Daly Avenue.

2. The City Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper Land Registry Office.

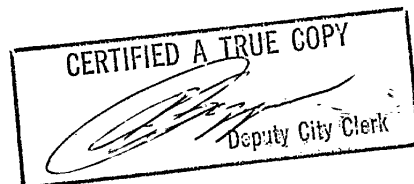

SCHEDULE "A"

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Ottawa, in the County of Carleton, in the Province of Ontario and Dominion of Canada BEING COMPOSED OF City Building Lots Numbers Ten (10) and Eleven (11) on the North side of Daly Street in the City of Ottawa, on a plan registered in the Land Registry Office of Ottawa - Carleton No. 5 as Plan No. 6.

SCHEDULE "B"

"St. Alban the Martyr Anglican Church, 125 Daly Avenue, consecrated in 1867, is recommended for designation as being of architectural and historical value. The oldest Anglican Church in Ottawa, St. Alban's was designed by King Arnoldi, student of Thomas Fuller. A landmark building in historic Sandy Hill, this charming English country-style church with Gothic detailing was the parish church for numerous prominent figures from the Confederation Era."
