BY-LAW NUMBER 188-97

A by-law of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa amending By-law Number 129-97.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa passed By-law Number 129-97 which was a by-law designating certain lands to be of historic and architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the lands to be included were described as lands and premises known municipally as 2370 Carling Avenue more particularly described in Schedule "A" to By-law Number 129-97;

AND WHEREAS a typographical error has been noted in the municipal address in By-law Number 129-97;

 $\label{the council of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa\ enacts} as\ \text{follows:}$

- 1. By-law Number 129-97 entitled "A by-law of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa to designate 2370 Carling Avenue to be of historic and architectural value or interest" is amended by striking out the expression, "2370 Carling Avenue" wherever it occurs therein and substituting therefor the expression, "2730 Carling Avenue" in each case.
- 2. The Corporation is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" of By-law Number 129-97 in the proper Land Registry Office.
