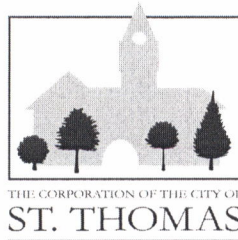

INTENT TO DESIGNATE - ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT**

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that, as a result of information provided by the City's Municipal Heritage Committee, City Council has initiated the "Intent to Designate" process for 225 Wellington Street, MCR Locomotive Repair Shops, as found within the Ontario Heritage Act. Please find enclosed a document outlining the reasons for the proposed designation.

A notice of Intent to Designate will be published in the local newspaper on Wednesday, October 22, 2014. After a 30 day period, should no objection be received about this matter, Council will consider a by-law to designate the property.

## **NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE PLACES OF CULTURAL HERITAGE VALUE OR INTEREST**

**Notice is Hereby Given** that the Council of the Corporation of the City of St. Thomas intends to designate as a place of cultural heritage value or interest the properties known as:

- McKay-Mulligan House, 76 Talbot Street, St. Thomas
- CASO Station, 750 Talbot Street, St. Thomas
- MCR Locomotive Repair Shops, Elgin County Railway Museum, 225 Wellington Street, St. Thomas

The detailed reasons for designation of these properties can be seen in or obtained from the Office of the CAO/Clerk, City Hall, 545 Talbot Street, St. Thomas, Ontario during normal office hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday).

Any person who objects to the intended designations shall within thirty days after the date of publication of this notice, serve on the CAO/Clerk, a notice of objection in writing, setting out the objection and all relevant facts. The last day for filing an objection is November 21, 2014.
