BY-LAW NO. 42 -79

Being a By-Law to amend By-Law No. 5-79 (O'Brien Apartments).

WHEREAS section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, S.O. 1974 Chapter 122 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural and/or historic value or interest; and

 $\frac{W\ H\ E\ R\ E\ A\ S}{did\ enact\ By-Law\ No.}$ the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew did enact By-Law No. 5-79 to designate, pursuant to said Act, the property known municipally as the O'Brien Apartments, 340 Raglan Street, South; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation deems it advisable to include a penalty clause in said By-Law;

 $\frac{NON}{TOWN}$ THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Renfrew enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-Law No. 5-79 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection:
 - "4. That every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-Law or of the Ontario Heritage Act, S.O. 1974, Chapter 122, as amended, or regulations thereunder, is quilty of an offence and on summary conviction is liable to a fine not to exceed the maximum penalty established by said Act and amendments thereto."
- 2. That the municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule A to By-Law No. 5-79 in the proper land registry office.
- 3. That the Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation.
- That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passing thereof.
