



BY-LAW NO. 18-2000

BEING a by-law to designate the property being part of Lot 43, more particularly described as Parts 2 and 3, RP 52R-3924, Newington, Ontario as being of historical value.

WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18, s.29, authorizes Council to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Council has authorized the notice of intention to designate the property being part of Lot 43, more particularly described as Parts 2 and 3, RP 52R-3924, Newington, Ontario;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Stormont enacts as follows:

- 1) To designate as historical value, the building owned by the Corporation of the Township of South Stormont and known as the former Forbes Memorial Library being part of Lot 43, more particularly described as Parts 2 and 3, RP 52R-3924, Newington, Ontario.

- 3) The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the Standard Freeholder.
