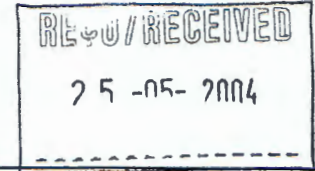

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BY-LAW NO. 259-2004
(Under the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18)



TAKE NOTICE that on April 16, 2004, Toronto City Council adopted By-law No. 259-2004, which designates the area shown on the map below (**Cabbagetown North Heritage Conservation District**) as a Heritage Conservation District under Part V of the Ontario Heritage Act.

Any person who objects to the By-law may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board by filing a notice of appeal with the City Clerk, **Attention: Frances Pritchard**, Administrator, Toronto South Community Council, Toronto City Hall, 4th Floor, West, 100 Queen Street West, Toronto, Ontario M5H 2N2, no later than **June 21, 2004**.

A Notice of Appeal must:

- (1) set out the objection and the reasons in support of the objection; and
- (2) be accompanied by the fee prescribed under the Ontario Municipal Board Act in the amount of \$125.00 payable by cheque to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario.

The By-law will come into force on June 22, 2004 if no notice of appeal is received on or before June 21, 2004.
