While the Coliseum complex is most closely identified with the annual Canadian National Exhibition and the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair, it is also the largest trade and consumer show location in Canada. The Coliseum and its additions are distinguished by their architectural detailing. The complex reflects the development of the livestock compounds and exhibition functions in this location over a forty-year period and is a microcosm of the continual evolution of the site.

The Toronto Historical Board's Heritage Property Report (Long Statement of Reasons for Designation) respecting the property is available for viewing at the City Clerk's Department, City Hall and the offices of the Toronto Historical Board.
