**TAKE NOTICE THAT** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Windsor intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known municipally as 3652 Peter Street as a property of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act.

**PROPERTY:** 3652 Peter Street (Part Lot 22, Registered Plan 40), known as the Sandwich First Baptist Church

**OWNER:** Trustees of Sandwich First Baptist Church

REASONS FOR DESIGNATION

- believed to be the oldest church built by and for the Black Community in Canada;
- built in 1851 by former slaves;
- built of hand-made bricks of clay from the banks of the Detroit River;
- early windows and gothic-arched with radiating brick voussoirs;
- original roof had wood shingles.

Any person may, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, being **December 31, 1994** send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Windsor notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Windsor shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
