municipally as 4709 DUNDAS STREET WEST, in the Borough  
of Etobicoke, in the Municipality of Metropolitan  
Toronto, in the Province of Ontario.

NOTICE OF INTENTION  
TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of  
the Borough of Etobicoke, on the 8th day of December, 1975,  
resolved to designate the lands and buildings known  
municipally as 4709 DUNDAS STREET WEST, as a property of  
historic and architectural value under the Ontario Heritage  
Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

The reason for the proposed designation is that the  
building, Montgomery's Inn, is of both architectural and  
historical significance. Architecturally, it is an  
excellent example of Loyalist Georgian architecture. Built  
of local river stone, the exterior shows typical Georgian  
proportioning and main entrance surrounded by fanlight and  
sidelights. The interior has been restored to its original  
lay-out, including early colours on walls, mouldings, etc.  
Historically the Inn was a focal point for community  
activity in the years 1832 - 1857. As well as functioning  
as an informal gathering place for both local people and  
travellers, Circuit Court and Township meetings were held  
in the ballroom. The inn has been restored to the period  
1850-55 and now functions as an historic site.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served  
on the Borough Clerk within thirty days of December 17th,  
1975.
