NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BY-LAW NO. 1328-2015 (Under the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18)

TAKE NOTICE that on December 10, 2015, Toronto City Council enacted By-law 1328-2015, which designates the St. Lawrence Neighbourhood Heritage Conservation District (area shown on attached map) under Part V of the Ontario Heritage Act. The By-law also adopts the St. Lawrence Neighbourhood Heritage Conservation District Plan, dated November 2015 as the District Plan.

Any person who objects to the By-law may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board by filing a notice of appeal with the City Clerk, Attention: Rosalind Dyers, Administrator, Toronto and East York Community Council, Toronto City Hall, 100 Queen Street West, 2nd Floor West, Toronto, ON, M5H 2N2, no later than March 21, 2016.

A Notice of Appeal must:

- 1. set out the objection and the reasons in support of the objection; and
- 2. be accompanied by the fee prescribed under the Ontario Municipal Board Act in the amount of \$125.00 payable by cheque to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario.

The By-law will come into force on December 10, 2015, if no notice of appeal is received on or before March 21, 2016.

Explanatory Note Heritage Conservation District Designation By-Law

On December 9 and 10, 2015, Toronto City Council adopted By-law No. 1328-2015, which designated the area shown on the map attached to this note as the St. Lawrence Neighbourhood Heritage Conservation District (the District) under Part V of the Ontario Heritage Act (the Act). The By-law also adopts the St. Lawrence Neighbourhood Heritage Conservation District Plan, dated November 2015.



Alterations to Property

The purpose of By-law No. 1328-2015 is to conserve and maintain the heritage character of the St. Lawrence Neighbourhood Heritage Conservation District. This is accomplished by requiring certain alterations to buildings within the District to conform to District Policies and Guidelines which are included in the District Plan. Typically, these alterations only relate to portions of the property that are visible from the street. If the proposed alteration conforms to the District Policies and Guidelines will be referred to City Council for consideration. No heritage permit is required for interior work, painting, and repairs using the same materials or exterior work that is not visible from the street.


Demolition and Infill

Under By-law 1328-2015, owners of property are required to apply for a heritage permit before demolishing any building, or erecting any new building in the District. Applications are referred to City Council for consideration. If City Council refuses the permit, the applicant may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board.
