TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Collingwood passed By-law No. 2012-020 on the 6th day of February, 2012 under Section 41.1 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18, as amended.

Amending By-law No. 2012-020 pertains to a parcel of land located on the northwest corner of Hume Street and Ste. Marie Street and is known locally as the site of the proposed "Admiral's Village" development.

THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of this amendment is to revise certain objectives and guidelines contained in the Town's HCD Plan including Part III titled Objectives and Policies and Part V titled Design Guidelines of the HCD Plan.
