OF CULTURAL HERITAGE VALUE OR INTEREST**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of The Corporation of the City of London intends to designate as a property of cultural heritage value or interest the following property in accordance with the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*:

4402 Colonel Talbot Road	June 30, 2016	August 2, 2016

The Lambeth Continuation School (later known as the M. B. McEachren Public School) was built at 4402 Colonel Talbot Road in 1925 to provide an opportunity for Lambeth students to pursue a higher education beyond the elementary school level. The School was designed by Herbert Carrol McBride in the Beaux Arts style to reflect the importance of education within the growing community.

A statement explaining the cultural heritage value or interest of this property and a description of the heritage attributes of this property can be seen in or obtained from the Office of the City Clerk, Room 308, City Hall, 300 Dufferin Avenue, London, Ontario N6A 4L9 during normal office hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday). Any person who objects to any intended designation must, **within thirty days** after the date of the first publication, serve on the City Clerk a notice of objection in writing, setting out the reason for the objection and all relevant facts. The *Ontario Heritage Act* provides that where a notice of objection has been served, the Council shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
