Dear Sir or Madam,

Re: **Notice of passage of by-laws designating the Russell Avenue- Range Road and the Besserer-Wurtemberg Heritage Conservation Districts under Part V of the Ontario Heritage Act.**

City Council, at its meeting held on Wednesday, September 26, 2018 passed By-law 2018-338 and By-law 2018-339, with reference to the above-noted matters:

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to designate the Russell Avenue-Range Road Heritage Conservation District.

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to designate the Besserer-Wurtemberg Heritage Conservation District.

Section 41 (4) of the *Ontario Heritage Act* establishes that any person who wishes to object to the passing of either by-law noted above, may appeal to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal (LPAT) by submitting their objection in writing, outlining the reasons for appeal and any other relevant information to the City Clerk. Such objection must be received by the City Clerk within 30 days of the publication of the notice of passage (by Monday October 29, 2018). The LPAT has established a filing fee of \$300.00. A cheque or money order made payable to the Minister of Finance must accompany the appeal letter.

If you would like a copy of the plan in English, please contact MacKenzie Kimm. The final plan, in French and English, will be posted on the City of Ottawa website after the expiration of the appeal period. If appeals are received, the plan will be posted after the appeals are heard.
