

**BY-LAW NO. 02-1102**

of the

**CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF COLLINGWOOD**



Being a By-law to designate the Town of Collingwood Heritage Conservation District

**WHEREAS** subsections 1 and 3 of section 41 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O, 1990 Chapter 0.18, as amended, provides as follows:

41. (1) Subject to subsection (2), where there is in effect in a municipality an official plan that contains provisions relating to the establishment of heritage conservation districts, the council of the municipality may by by-law designate the municipality or any defined area or areas thereof as a heritage conservation district.

(2) A by-law passed under subsection (1) does not come into force without the approval of the Board.

**AND WHEREAS** the Official Plan of the Town of Collingwood contains provisions relating to the establishment of heritage conservation districts;

**AND WHEREAS** it is intended to designate the area defined by the said by-law

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Collingwood enacts as follows:

1. THAT the area of the Town of Collingwood more particularly shown on Schedule "A" hereto annexed and forming part of this by-law, is hereby designated as the Collingwood Heritage Conservation District.
2. THAT the Deputy Clerk is hereby authorized to make application to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval of this by-law.
3. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of approval by the Ontario Municipal Board.

**ENACTED AND PASSED** this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December, 2002.
