TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of The Corporation of the City of Guelph at its meeting held on Monday, February 5th, 1990, refused the application of the Ker Cavan property municipally known as 20 Stuart Street in the City of Guelph, in the Province of Ontario, which has been designated by by-law as a property of architectural and historical significance.

AND TAKE NOTICE THAT in refusing this application, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Guelph hereby prohibits any work to demolish or remove any building or structure on this portion of the property for a period of one hundred and eighty (180) days.

AND TAKE NOTICE THAT this prohibition period may be extended by agreement between The Corporation of the City of Guelph and the owner.

AND TAKE NOTICE THAT upon the expiration of this prohibition period on August 4th, 1990, and where there has not been an agreement to extend the prohibition for a further period of time, the owner may proceed to demolish or remove the building or structure on the property subject to the provisions of any other Act or regulation thereunder.
