### Notice of Decision to Consent

## Heritage Permit Application for Removal of a Structure pursuant to subsection 34(2) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O.1990, c.18

#### RE: 2722 County Road 42, Town of Lakeshore, Community of St. Joachim.

**TAKE NOTICE** that Lakeshore Town Council, on September 24, 2019, passed a resolution to permit the removal and relocation of the structure, known as the Sacred Heart of Jesus (the monument), located at 2722 County Road 42, to the nearby cemetery to the west, subject to the terms and conditions noted below:

# The owner provide a detailed dismantling, storage and reconstruction plan to the satisfaction of the Manager of Development Services and Manager of Building Services.

The subject site is designated under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act and the monument is a heritage attribute of the property.

If the council of a municipality consents to an application subject to terms and conditions or refuses an application, the owner of the property that was the subject of the application may appeal the council's decision to the Tribunal within 30 days of the day the owner received notice of the council's decision. An owner of property who wishes to appeal the decision of the council of a municipality shall, within 30 days of the day the owner received notice of the council's decision, give notice of appeal to the Tribunal and to the clerk of the municipality. A notice of appeal shall set out the reasons for the objection to the decision of the council of the municipality and be accompanied by the fee charged under the *Local Planning Appeal Tribunal Act, 2017.* 2017, c. 23, Sched. 5, s. 64.
