S.S. #7 LAKESHORE SCHOOL: REASONS FOR DESIGNATION UNDER THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, 1990, CHAPTER 0.18

After 35 years as a school the frame structure was moved to the opposite end of Lot 19, Woodhouse, to become the "new" home of the Jamieson family. Its solid construction is evident in the original thick, wide tongue and groove siding, the unusual 12 over 8 double hung windows and the wainscotting which still borders the interior.

The three surviving elevations have been attached to the north elevation of the Marburg Community Hall, originally a Church of the Messiah, now a designated Heritage Building.
