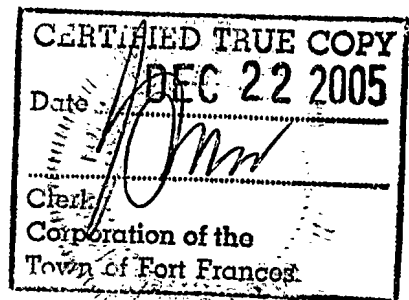

TOWN OF FORT FRANCES

BY-LAW NO.56/90-B

(Being a by-law to repeal By-Law No. 56/90, a by-law to designate the property municipally known as 235 Scott Street (Rainy Lake Hotel) as being of architectural; and historical value or interest - the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990 c. O.18, (the "Act") Section 32.)

WHEREAS on July 23rd, 1990, Council enacted By-Law No. 56/90 to designate property municipally known as 235 Scott Street (Rainy Lake Hotel) as being of architectural; and historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS by letter dated October 7th, 2005, the owner of property municipally known as 235 Scott Street (Rainy Lake Hotel), requested that Council repeal By-Law No. 56/90;

AND WHEREAS on November 14th, 2005, Council approved a recommendation from the Planning Advisory Committee that serves as the municipal heritage committee, to repeal By-Law No. 56/90;


AND WHEREAS notice of Council's intent to repeal By-Law No. 56/90 was published in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality as required by the Act.

NOW THEREFORE Council for the Corporation of the Town of Fort Frances HEREBY ENACTS as follows:


1. That Town of Fort Frances By-Law No. 56/90 be repealed.

This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof.
