BY-LAW NUMBER 6-84

A By-Law to designate the property known municipally as 52 Wharf Street, L'Orignal, Ontario as being of architectural and historical value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of L'Orignal has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as 52 Wharf Street at L'Orignal, Ontario and upon The Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of L'Orignal enacts as follows:

- There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property at 52 Wharf Street, L'Orignal, Ontario. (more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto).
- The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office.
- 3) The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the onwer of the aforesaid property and on The Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD time and finally passed this 8th day of February 1984.

Those lands and premises located in the following municipality, namely, in the Village of L'Orignal, in the County of Prescott and Province of Ontario,

and being composed of Village Lots Numbers ONE(1) and TWO(2) on the North side of Marston Street in the said Village as laid down on a plan of that Village made by the late Robert Hamilton, Esq., P.L.S., and filed in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the County of Prescott on the 25th day of March, 1881.

SUBJECT to expropriation in favour of the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario for and on behalf of Her Majesty The Queen by Instrument dated the 12th day of June, 1963, and registered in the Registry Office for the County of Prescott on the 14th day of June, 1963, as Number 5056-C.
