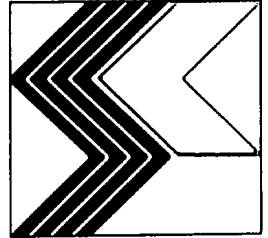

Enclosed are copies of the following By-laws:

By-law No. 90-394 - A By-law to repeal the By-law No. 78-357, designating the property at 24 Yates Street as being of historical and/or architectural value or interest.

By-law No. 90-395 - A By-law to designate the property at 24 Yates Street as being of historical and/or architectural value or interest.

The subject property which was designated a Heritage Property by By-law No. 78-357, has been severed into three lots by authority of the Land Division Committee for the Niagara Region.

It was necessary for Council, therefore, to enact a new By-law to describe the revised boundaries of the designated property as Part of Lot 1189, C.P. 2, designated as Part 2 on Reference Plan 30R-6038 (24 Yates Street).

In accordance with the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act a public notice will be published in the St. Catharines Standard respecting this matter. On September 1st 1990, the City of St. Catharines published a notice of its intention to repeal Designating By-law No. 78-357 and to enact a new designating by-law respecting the above-noted property.

A By-law to repeal By-law No. 78-357 entitled "A By-law to designate the property at No. 24 Yates Street of architectural value and of historic interest."


THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ST. CATHARINES enacts as follows:
