- 2. Directed the City Clerk to refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board, if the owner appeals City Council's decision to refuse the application under Section 32 of the Ontario Heritage Act to repeal the designating by-law,

Notice of Appeal:

A notice of appeal shall set out the reasons for objection to the decision of the Council of the municipality and must be received on or before July 13, 2009.
