NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of East Gwillimbury intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal addresses as properties of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, S.O. Chapter 337.

 a. Joe Kelley's Bridge (Green Lane between the Second Concession Road and Leslie Street)

The reasons for designation of this swing bridge, spanning the Holland River, are both architectural and historical. The bridge was built in 1911 and is listed on a joint list of Heritage Bridges in Ontario by the Ministry of Transportation and the Ministry of Culture, Tourism and Recreation.

Any person may, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk-Administrator of the Town of East Gwillimbury, notice of his or her objection to the proposed designations together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and relevant facts. If such Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the own of East Gwillimbury shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a Hearing.
