Take notice that the Council of the Corporation  
of the Borough of North York on the 13th day of  
March, 1978 decided to designate the lands and  
buildings, known municipally as 9 Barberry Place as  
a property of historic and architectural value or  
interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974,  
S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed  
Designation:

Thomas Clark House, 1855. The building is recom-  
mended for designation on architectural grounds  
because it is a classic example of a rural dwelling  
fashioned in the Georgian style. The simple, solid  
front facade exhibits all the features of a Georgian  
house: it is constructed of red brick; it is twice as  
long as the sides; and, its symmetry is displayed  
through a central doorway with two equally-spaced  
windows on either side. Although modern dwellings are  
encroaching along three sides of the property, the  
remaining bit of green space has been so landscaped as  
to enhance the rural quality of this house.

Notice of objection to the designation may be  
served on the Clerk within thirty days of April 7th,  
1978.
