## BY-LAW: 85-07

## "A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE A PROPERTY AND PREMISES PURSUANT TO PART IV - ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT."

WHEREAS: Notice of intent to pass a by-law to designate the real property and premises at Lot 3, north part of Lot 6 according to Plan 40 Village of Spencerville was published in the Kemptville Weekly Advance and Prescott Journal on March 20th, 27th and April 3, 1985; AND WHEREAS: No notice of objection to the intent to designate was received;

AND WHEREAS: It is desired to conserve the historical, architectural, asthetic and scenic character of the exterior of the building

being located on the property heretofore and hereinafter quoted; AND WHEREAS: the building thereon was constructed during the 1850's as a

two storey field stone general store and is symbolic of field stone general stores constructed within rural Ontario during the mid nineteenth to early twentieth century;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Edwardsburgh enacts as follows:

 That the real property and premises being Lot 3, North part of Lot 6 according to Plan 40, Village of Spencerville is hereby designated pursuant to Part IV, The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337 as amended.

 That the Head of Council and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Corporation an Easement Agreement with the present owner of said designated premises and property.

READ A FIRST TIME this 22nd day of April, 1985. READ A SECOND TIME this 22nd day of April, 1985. READ A THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED this 22nd day of April, 1985.
