



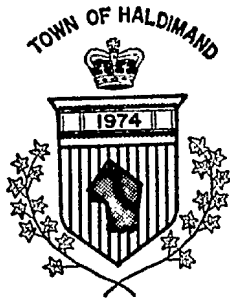

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Haldimand intends to designate a small steel bridge over Black Creek located on Highway 54 between Caledonia and York, as a property of historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, S.O. Chapter 337.

Reasons for proposed Designation

Constructed 1912 by Melvin Runchey. Steel structure cost \$1000.00 from Hamilton Bridge Works, lumber and cement from Caledonia Milling Co. Handled traffic until 1950 when Highway rebuilt. Is only bridge of this type left in area. Example of early road needs.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Town of Haldimand before the Twenty-Second Day of November 1984.
