TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE WELLINGTON

BY-LAW NO. 2006-020

Being a By-law to designate 249 Saint Patrick Street East in the former Town of Fergus, to be of cultural heritage value or interest

WHEREAS on the advice of the Municipal Heritage Committee, Council has been advised to designate the property noted below to be of cultural heritage value or interest to the provisions of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18;

AND WHEREAS the provisions of Section 29, Subsections (1), (2), (3) and (4) have been complied with and no objection has been received by the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE WELLINGTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The lands and premises described as 249 St. Patrick Street East, Plan 55, Lot 60, N/S St. Patrick St. East, (Formerly Town of Fergus), now in Township of Centre Wellington are hereby designated to be a building of cultural heritage value or interest.

2. The reasons for the designation are as follows:

Cultural Heritage Value or Interest:

This typical 1½ storey Ontario farmhouse built in 1870, has a rectangular plan long façade with coursed rubble walls and large limestone quoins. The windows are primarily double-hung 6/6. The centre gable window features a rounded arch with a simplified gothic tracery. The centre gable is decorated with a. A recent addition on the east side is excluded from the designation.

Heritage Attributes to be protected:

All exterior limestone walls. Decorative looped gothic fascia with a carved finial. All window frames and pane distribution.

- 3. This By-law shall be registered against the title of the lands described 249 St. Patrick Street East, Plan 55, Lot 60, N/S St. Patrick St. East, (Formerly Town of Fergus), now in Township of Centre Wellington
- 4. This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon its final passing.
