NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Goderich , on the 13th day of July 1981, decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as Robert Gibbons House as a property of architectural and/or historical significance under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

REASON FOR PROPOSED DESIGNATION

"The Robert Gibbons House". The Robert Gibbons House is recommended for historical and architectural reasons. The Gibbons house is a cubic Georgian structure. It is constructed of cut stone, in tapering thickness from 3 ft at the base to 1½ ft. at the second level, covered on the interior by split lath and plaster. Cut locally, the dressed stone on the front facade comes from the Maitland River. The front facade has been restored to its original appearance. Other details include three of fcur symmetrically placed chimneys on a square, low hipped roof; six over six windows and a front door with side and transom lites.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Town Clerk within thirty days of the 15th day of July 1981.
