NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Centre Wellington intends to designate the properties, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal addresses as properties of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990 (Ch.O.18, Sec. 29)

Fergus

270 Bridge Street

Est. 1850 single detached dwelling, rectangular plan long façade, centre façade main entrance on Union Street with basement entrance on Bridge Street, cut/broken course limestone with cut quoins, 11/2 storey centre gable.

275 Hill Street West

1875 single detached dwelling, rectangular plan long façade, stretcher brick, 11/2 storey centre gable.

425 Provost Lane

1865 multiple detached dwelling, rectangular short façade, cut/broken course limestone with cut quoins, 11/2 storey off-centre gable and other gables.

499 St. George Street West

1865 single detached dwelling, rectangular plan long façade, cut/broken course limestone with cut quoins, medium gable roof, centre façade gable, entry centre façade.

249 St. Patrick Street East

1870 single detached dwelling, rectangular plan long façade, cut limestone broken course walls, 11/2 storey, centre gable, entry centre façade, two sash windows 6/6, medium gable, centre gable.

200 Tower Street South

1870 single detached dwelling, rectangular plan long façade, red stretcher brick walls with cut stone quoins, 11/2 storey, medium gable roof, two gables, main entrance centre façade, centre chimney.

445 Tower Street South

1863 single detached dwelling, rectangular long façade, stucco walls, 11/2 storey, centre gable.

490 Tower Street South

1882 single detached dwelling, rectangular long façade, broken limestone walls, cut stone quoins, medium gable roof, $1\frac{1}{2}$ storey, centre gable, side chimneys left and right.

276 Union Street East

Est. 1880, single detached dwelling, machine made red stretcher brick, square plan, entry right façade, two storey, bellcast roof with gable centre façade, sash windows 6/6 and 4/4 in gable, stone basement.

240 Union Street West

1868 single detached dwelling, rectangular plan long façade, cut limestone broken course walls, two storey, entry centre façade, two and three sash windows 6/6, centre façade, medium gable roof, side chimneys left & right.

/ 245 Union Street West

1855 single detached dwelling, rectangular plan long facace, cut limestone broken course walls, single storey, full basement below ground, medium hip roof, entry centre façade, two sash windows ½ long façade.

Elora

80 Colborne Street

1896 single detached dwelling, rectangular short façade, stretcher brick, 2¹/₂ storey, medium gable.

22 David Street West

1874 single detached dwelling, rectangular long façade, stucco walls, centre gable, side chimneys left and right, main entrance centre façade, two sash windows 6/6, low gable roof, centre gable.

J 249 Geddes Street

1891 single detached dwelling, irregular plan, two storeys, red stretcher brick, quoins, medium hip roof with projecting eaves and brackets, entrance off-centre façade.

260 Geddes Street

J

1889 single detached dwelling, rectangular short façade, stretcher brick, single storey, quoins, description & date stone, medium gable.

40 McNab Street West

1864 single detached dwelling, rectangular long façade, stretcher brick with quoins, medium gable roof with centre gable façade, two side chimneys (left & right), main entrance centre façade.

30 Moir Street

Built in 1867 for John Godfrey, shoemaker. Godfrey was Reeve of Elora from 1878-80 and Postmaster from 1884-92. Red brick with yellow brick quoins and windows trimmed with yellow brick, standard centre hall plan. Pine floors and trim original.

193 Princess Street

1868 single detached dwelling, rectangular long façade, stretcher brick, low hip roof, main entrance centre façade, two sash windows 2/2 long façade.

200 Smith Street

Built in 1895 for the Rev. Dr. James Middlemiss who served for 30 years as first Pastor of Chalmers Church. Original small red brick home features and unusual turret over the front entrance which is subtended by a large stained glass oculus. Also of note are the ruby stained glass transoms over the original front door, inscribed "Mansfield Cottage" and the cherry staircase with curved string at the landing.

201 Smith Street

1873 single detached dwelling, rectangular long façade, stone walls with tape pointing, $1\frac{1}{2}$ storey, centre gable, sash windows 6/6.

J 45 Water Street

Est. 1840 single detached dwelling, rectangular plan long façade, stucco walls probably log construction, medium gable roof, side chimney left.

Salem

19 George Street

1880 single detached dwelling, rectangular short façade, two storeys, coursed limestone rubble with cut quoins, medium gable.

275 Geddes Street

Est. 1867, single detached dwelling, rectangular plan long façade with enclosed veranda, stone with tape pointing, main entrance centre façade, low gable roof, sash windows 6/6.

Nichol

7003 Highway # 6

Est. 1860, single detached dwelling, L-shape plan, 1¹/₂ storey, hand made stretcher red brick walls, yellow brick quoins and voussoires, medium gable roof with additional gable centre façade, single chimney right centre.

West Garafraxa

6666 Second Line

4 5 1

1855, single detached dwelling, L-shape plan, two storey, squared field stone with finished quoins, main entrance centre façade, medium gable roof, modern windows.

7053 First Line

Est. 1870, single detached dwelling, L-shape plan, 1 ½ storey, squared field stone, main entrance centre façade, medium gable roof with gable right façade, triple bay window left façade, decorated roof trim.
