NOTICE OF INTENTION

TO DESIGNATE

Borough of North York, 5000 Yonge Street, Willowdale, Ontario Mr. A.B.R. Lawrence, Q.C., Chairman, Ontario Heritage Foundation, 77 Bloor Street West, 7th Floor, Toronto, Ontario.

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Borough of North York on the 11th day of October, 1977 decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as 1650 Finch Avenue East as a property of architectural value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

Zion Primitive Methodist Church, 1873. The building is recommended for designation because it is a fine example of a simple rural church fashioned in the Gothic style. The simple rectangular form of the building is enlivened by red patterned white brick buttresses, chimneys and an arched belfry. The church sits in restful solitude, against a new subdivision developing around it.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of November 30th, 1977.
