NOTICE OF INTENTION

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of North York on the 15th day of December, 1980, decided to designate the lands and building known municipally as 4111 Yonge Street as a property of historic value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation.

The C.W. Jefferys House, 4111 Yonge Street is recommended for designation for historic reasons as the home of C.W. Jefferys, who lived here from 1914 to 1941. Jefferys was an important illustrator and recorder of Canadian life and history, who actively encouraged the development of a uniquely Canadian school of painting. Stylistically, the house is late Gothic Revival, with a very steep center gable and heavy pierced bargeboards, although this was added to an earlier three-bay brick house.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the City Clerk within thirty days of December 22nd, 1980.
