
Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of  
the City of Toronto, on the 12th day of April, 1977, decided  
to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as  
No.441 Jarvis Street, as a property of architectural value  
or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, 1974 S.O.  
Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The house at 441 Jarvis Street is recommended for  
designation for architectural reasons in context with adjacent  
houses to the north. Built in 1881, it is a good example of  
simple domestic architecture that incorporated bold decorative  
brickwork and distinctive wood trim and ornamental brackets at  
the gabled roof overhangs.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served  
on the Clerk within thirty days of the 22nd day of April, 1977.
