THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF BRACEBRIDGE

BY-LAW 82-63

BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS THE TOWN LIBRARY AT 94 MANITOBA STREET BRACEBRIDGE ONTARIO AS BEING OF HISTORIC OR ARCHITECHTURAL VALUE OR INTEREST

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Ch. 337, authorizes the council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all the buildings and structures thereon, to be of historic or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bracebridge has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as The Bracebridge Town Library, 94 Manitoba Street, Bracebridge, Ontario, more particularly described in Schedule"A" attached hereto, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the municipality, once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS the reasons for designation are set out in Schedule "B" attached hereto;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the said Municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Bracebridge enacts as follows:

- There is designated as being of historic and/or architectural value or interest the real property known as The Bracebridge Town Library at 94 Manitoba Street, more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- The Town Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office, at Bracebridge, for Muskoka.
- The Town Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served upon the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this by-law to be published each of 3 consecutive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the Town of Bracebridge.

SHORT STATEMENT OF THE REASONS FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION

The Bracebridge Town Library, located at 94 Manitoba Street, is recommended for designation for architectural reasons, as an example of neo-Classical design with Romanesque accents. The interior is Greek Revival-Ionic, and the building itself is constructed from Muskoka Stone.

Historically the building has served as a focal point for activities and as a civic symbol since 1906, and generally epitomizes and reflects the nature of the surrounding district.

The Town Library is a prominent structure on a high point in town at the intersection of Manitoba Street and Dominion Street, and its retention is important for preserving the character of the surrounding area.
