Anyone may appeal the repeal of a portion of the Designating By-law to the Conservation Review Board by filing a notice of appeal, setting out the reasons for the appeal with the Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Niagara Falls, within 30 days of the receipt of this notice. Receipt of Notice is deemed to be 7 days from the date of mailing.

The last day for filing a notice of appeal is July 28, 2014

The decision of the Council of the Corporation of the City of Niagara Falls is final if a notice of appeal is not received before or on the last day for filing a notice of appeal.
