NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener intends to designate the property at the following municipal address as a property of historic and architectural value under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

The subject property is located at 56 Duke Street West. It is intended that in particular, the exterior walls, the stained glass windows, the towers, the slate roof and the rose window over the front door of St. Mary Our Lady of the Seven Sorrows Church, be designated.

The designation described herein is recommended due to the historic and architectural significance of this church. The church was constructed in 1900 and designed in the style of a western European cathedral in the shape of a Latin cross. In terms of architecture, the church possesses several significant details, including stained glass windows, the towers, the slate roof, and the rose window over the front door.

Any person may, within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Kitchener notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
