NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE A PROPERTY OF HISTORICAL OR ARCHITECTURAL VALUE.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Kincardine intends to designate as property of historical or architectural value or interest, the following property for the following reasons:

PROPERTY:

796 Princes Street in the Town of Kincardine.

REASONS:

A large home with claybrick (double and possibly triple) exterior walls. The roof has slate shingles. Three interior fireplaces, each with a different hardwood mantle. Interior woodwork is largely of hardwood including cherry, white ash or chestnut and some maple. The cellar is full height, with fieldstone walls.

Any person who objects to this proposed designation shall, within thirty days after the date of publication of this notice, serve on the Town Clerk a notice, in writing, setting out the objection and all relevant facts to:
