NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

To: Ontario Heritage Foundation,

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cornwall
intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known
municipally as 29 Second Street West as a property of architectural and
historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act,
1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

Reasons for the Proposed Designation

The Capitol Theatre, 29 Second Street West, is recommended for
designation as being of architectural and historical value. The Capitol
Theatre was constructed in 1927 as a deluxe movie house and was adapted
to show talking motion pictures in 1929. Once an excellent example of
a type of theatre, the Capitol is now one of a very few such structures of
that kind remaining in the province. The following specific areas are of
particular architectural and historical value and should be preserved:
the exterior marquee and the box office, the interior facades of the
auditorium from the proscenium arch back to and including the south arch,
the atmospheric ceiling and all parapets and brass railings in the auditorium,
and all Grecian plaster designs in the foyer and vestibule.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement
of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the
Clerk of the City of Cornwall before the 19th day of September ,
1979.
