BY-LAW NO. 44, 1984 of the CITY OF CORNWALL

A By-law to designate the property known municipally as 224 Second Street East as being of architectural and historical value or interest

WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, ch. 337(29) il authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cornwall has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known municipally as 224 Second Street East and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the local newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cornwall enacts as follows -

1. THAT the real property known municipally as 224 Second Street East and more particularly described as the East half of lot 8 south side of Second Street in the City of Cornwall, County of Stormont shall be designated as being of architectural and historical value.
