Being a By-law to designate the property known municipally as 16 Kingston Road East, as being of architectural and historical value or interest.

WHEREAS Subsection 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Ajax has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the Davies House, 16 Kingston Road East, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Ajax enacts as follows:

16 Kingston Road East, more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto.

2. The municipal solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office.



This is the earliest two storey neoclassical house in the village, built about 1842. It has a 3 bay front and a hipped roof. It is a solid brick structure - now overlaid with aluminum siding but the original windows remain with 6/6 square headed panes and much of the original hand drawn glass. The front door, with its narrow transom and ½ side lights, is typical of the Pickering area.
