#### By-law 2013-54

### Bradford High School Heritage Designation By-law

A by-law to designate a property as being of Historic and/or Architectural Value or Interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act R.S.O. 1990, CHAPTER O.18

The Old Bradford High School

**WHEREAS** Pursuant to Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act* R.S.O. 1990, CHAPTER O.18, the council of a municipality is authorized to enact by-laws to designate a real property, including all or some of the buildings and structures thereon, to be of historic and/or architectural value or interest;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises at:

PLAN 77 PT LOTS 1 & 8, PLAN 105 LOTS 12 & 13 PT LOT 8, 14 TO 17 20 Fletcher Street (AKA 28 Queen Street) Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury

and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to designate the Old Bradford High School at 28 Queen Street, and has caused such notice of intention to be published once in a newspaper having a general circulation in the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** the reasons for designation are set out in Schedule 'B' attached hereto and form part of this by-law;

**NOW THEREFORE** The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. The following real property, more particularly described in Schedule 'A' attached hereto and forming part of this by-law is hereby designated as being of historic and/or architectural value or interest:

The Old Bradford High School 28 Queen Street Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury County of Simcoe

The Clerk is hereby authorized to register a copy of this by-law against the 2. property described in Schedule 'A' attached hereto in the property Simcoe County Land Registry Office.
