

## NOTICE OF DESIGNATION

Take notice that the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Perth at its meeting on January 27, 1981, adopted the following by-law.

## CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PERTH

## BY-LAW NO. 2381

A By-law to designate a certain property within the municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, designate a property within the municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate a certain property within the municipality was served on the owner of the property and the Ontario Heritage Foundation, December 19, 1980, and was published in the Perth Courier, December 23rd, 30th, 1980, and January 7th, 1981.

AND WHEREAS no objections were received against the designation of the said property as a result of the aforementioned notices;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Perth ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following property be and is hereby designated to be historic or architectural value or interest:

DESCRIPTION: OLD PERTH LIBRARY building at 77 Gore Street, East, Perth, Ontario (corner of Gore and Basin Streets) located on Part of Lot 5 on the North Side of Basin Street, Plan 8828.

OWNER: Perth Public Library Board.

REASON FOR DESIGNATION: This building is of visual significance to the total streetscape of the main street of Perth, Ontario.

The Library was built in 1907 and is one of the few remaining libraries built with a "Carnegie" grant. It is built of red and yellow (buff) brick designed after the Bank of Montreal building in Toronto.

This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the passing thereof.
