BY-LAW NUMBER 142-88

A by-law of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa designating an area within the limits of the City of Ottawa as a heritage conservation district.

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Ottawa has examined the area described in Schedule "A" and shown on Schedule "B" annexed hereto pursuant to the provisions of Section 40 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, chapter 337;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa has an approved Official Plan in effect that contains provisions relating to the establishment of heritage conservation districts;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa is empowered, pursuant to Section 41 of the said Ontario

Heritage Act, to designate any defined area of the municipality as a heritage conservation district;

THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

- 1. The area within the territorial limits of the City of
 Ottawa described in Schedule "A" and shown as Schedule "B" annexed
 hereto, is hereby designated as a heritage conservation district.
 - 2. The Schedules attached hereto and marked Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" form part of this by-law and all notations, references and other information contained therein shall be as much a part of this by-law as if all the matters and information set forth by the said Schedules were all fully described herein.
 - 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval of this by-law.

ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of Ottawa, in the Regional Municipality of Ottawa-Carleton, in the Province of Ontario and BEING COMPOSED OF:-


FIRSTLY: all of Lots 54, 55, 56, 57 and 58, on the north side of Gilmour Street, all of Lots 13, 14 and 15 on the east side of Elgin Street, all of Lots 1 and 2 on the west side of Granville Place, all of Lots 1 and 2 on the east side of Granville Place, and all of Lots 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 on the west side of Cartier Street, according to Registered Plan 15558.

SECONDLY: all that part of Lot 12 on the east side of — Cartier Street, Registered Plan 15558, designated as Parts 1, 2 and 3 on a plan of survey received and deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Ottawa-Carleton Number 5 as Plan 5R-6637.

THIRDLY: Lot 13 on the east side of Cartier Street, Registered Plan 15558, save and except the rear thirteen feet of said Lot 13, from front to rear.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION to the Ontario Municipal Board by The Corporation of the City of Ottawa for approval of a by-law to designate an area within the City of Ottawa as a heritage conservation district pursuant to Section 41 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, chapter 337.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa has applied to the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to the provisions of Section 41 of the Ontario Heritage Act for approval of By-law Number 142-88 passed on the 15th day of June, 1988. A map showing the lands affected is attached to this Notice and a copy of the by-law may be obtained at the Clerk's Office.

ANY PERSON INTERESTED MAY, within twenty-one (21) days after the date of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver personally to the Clerk of the City of Ottawa notice of objection to approval of the said by-law or part thereof giving details of all or the portion of the by-law to which you object and detailed reasons therefor, and shall indicate that the objector or an agent will attend at the hearing to support the objection.

ANY PERSON wishing to support the application for approval of the by-law may within twenty-one (21) days after the date of this notice send by registered mail or deliver personally to the Clerk of the City of Ottawa notice of his support of approval of the said by-law together with a request for notice of the hearing to be held giving also the name and address to which such notice should be given.


THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD may approve of the said by-law but before doing so it shall appoint a time and place when any support or objection to the by-law will be considered. Notice of any hearing will be given only to persons who have filed an objection or notice of support and who have left with or delivered to the Clerk undersigned, the address to which notice of hearing is to be sent.
