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BY-LAW 1993-06

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE ROCKLAND TOWN HALL, 1560 LAURIER STREET, AS BEING OF HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OR INTEREST

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Rockland has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the "Rockland Town Hall" at 1560 Laurier Street and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and


WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served to the clerk of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Rockland enacts as follows:

- Section 1: The real property known as the "Rockland Town Hall" at 1560 Laurier Street located on Part of Lots 26 and 27, Concession 1 (O.S.), Township of Clarence, County of Russell, being composed of Part of Lot 12, Plan A. Bell 1908, and Part 1, Plan 50R-289 and Part 2, Plan 50R-4598 designated as being of historical and architectural value or interest;
- Section 2: The Town legal advisor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property in the proper land registry office.
- Section 3: The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served to the owner of the aforesaid property and to the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

Section 4: This by-law shall become effective on the date of passing hereof subject to the expiry of the period for filing objections.
