NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE IN THE MATTER OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, R.S.O. 1990, CHAPTER 0.18, AS AMENDED, AND IN THE MATTER OF THE LANDS AND PREMISES KNOWN AS GRAHAMSVILLE CEMETERY, LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF AIRPORT ROAD, SOUTH OF STEELES AVENUE EAST (LOT 15, CON 6 EHS), IN THE CITY OF BRAMPTON, IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton under Council resolution PDD081-2008 intends to designate these lands and premises under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. 0.18, as amended.

Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest

The cultural heritage value of the Grahamsville Cemetery is related to its design value as a representative example of a rural historic Euro-Canadian cemetery with many early tombstones reflecting a high degree of craftsmanship. The property also has historical value reflecting the lives of early settlers and the history of the former cross roads hamlet of Grahamsville. The property also has contextual value as one of the remaining tangible elements of Grahamsville, also the landscaping elements and rural character.
