BY-LAW NO. 33-87

BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS THE HERITAGE PONY TRUSS BRIDGE, LOT 14, CONCESSION 10, MIDDLETOWN LINE, FORMER TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH NORWICH, AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST.

WHEREAS, SECTION 29 OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, 1980, authorizes the council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Norwich has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as THE HERITAGE PDNY TRUSS BRIDGE, Lot 14, Concession 10, Middletown Line, former Township of South Norwich, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks:

AND WHEREAS, no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Norwich enacts as follows:

- There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as THE HERITAGE PONY TRUSS BRIDGE, Lot 14, Concession 10, Middletown Line, former Township of South Norwich, more particularly described in SCHEDULE A hereto.
- The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule A hereto in the proper land registry office.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.
