NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BY-LAW No. 4809-06.D BY THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AURORA

TAKE NOTICE that on the 13th Day of June the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Aurora adopted By-law # 4809-06.D, which adopts the Heritage Conservation District Plan for Northeast Old Aurora, dated June 13, 2006, under the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O 1990, c. 0.18.

AND TAKE NOTICE THAT any individual, corporation or public body, may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the By-law by filing with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Aurora, **not later** than 4:30 p.m. on **Thursday, July 27, 2006.** A notice of appeal setting out the reasons in support of the objection, accompanied by the prescribed fee in the amount of \$125, made payable to the **Minister of Finance**. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or group on its behalf.



Explanatory Note

Re: By-law No.4809-06.D

By-law Number 4809-06.D has the following purpose and effect:

On June 13, 2005, the Council of the Town of Aurora adopted By-law No. 4804-06.D, which designated the area shown on the map attached to this note as the Northeast Old Aurora Heritage Conservation District (the District) under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S. O. 1990, c. O.18 (the Act). Council also adopted By-law No. 4809-06.D to adopt the Northeast Old Aurora Heritage Conservation District Plan.

The purpose of By-law 4809-06.D is to guide future change in the district as defined by By-law 4804-06.D through the District Plan, so that it harmonizes as much as possible with the heritage character of the neighbourhood.
